Advise the BWA Technical Officer of your name for recording on the workers' register.



Operate a stop watch to note times as advised.



Never done it before! The BWA Technical Officer will talk you through everything you need to do.



Record in your team match book: when your team's substitute players take the field for the first time.



Record in your team match book: goals scored by both teams (in order of scoring).



The BWA Technical Official looks after all behaviour issues - that is not your responsibility.



Record in your team match book: any Cards (Green, Yellow, Red) issued in the game.



Record in your team match book: your team's goal scorer/s with a tally mark.



The BWA Technical Officials looks after the watering and scoreboard – you don't have to do this.



Enjoy the best seat to watch the game, while providing valuable volunteer support for our sport.



Record in your team match book: the final score and game result at the end of the game and sign your book.



If you make a mistake, don't worry. Simple cross it out & put in what you meant to write.

BWA needs Technical Officials for all our Turf games and often we need to supply Technical Officials for HQ and HA Championships. So, if you enjoy working on the tech bench, how do you learn more?
