Registrations are now open for the BWHA 2024 Summer Hockey Program. The Program will run a series of 8-week competitions across Downey Park and Brisbane North Hockey Center (Burringbar Park).

Teams must register by 11 September 2024

Please see below information for the 2024 programs, which may differ from previous years:

- Monday Masters teams must register a minimum of 13 players including one (mandatory) GK.
- All other competitions (except Monday Masters) can play with just field players.
- 6-A-Side teams must nominate a minimum of eight (8) players per team.
- A minimum of 4 teams per competition is required.
- Penalty Corners (PCs) hits are not allowed for all 6-A-Side programs & Thursday Night Mixed.
 - If there is no GK, 5 field players defend the PC from the opposite side of the goal box to the injector (no one inside the goal box). No player has GK privileges and a helmet does not have to be worn.
 - 6-A-Side only the 6th defensive player will go to half way when a PC is awarded and can come back to defend once the ball has been injected by the attacking team.
- All 6-A-Side competitions
 - Only pushing or controlled jinking (below knee height) are allowed.
- Full field Monday Masters
- Hitting is allowed
 Thursday Night Full Fig
- Thursday Night Full Field Mixed
 - Slap hits
 - Slap hitting IS ALLOWED in the middle two quarters of the field.
 - Slap hitting IS NOT ALLOWED in the two end quarters including the circles with only pushing or flicking allowed in these areas.
 - Shots at goal are to be pushes or jinks BELOW the height of the back board.
- A deliberate breach in the circle by a defender will result in the awarding of a PC Penalty Strokes are NOT awarded in summer hockey.
- Players aged 13 years or older before the start of the summer program (7 October 2024) can play in the Senior Women's 6-A-Side.
- Players aged 15 years or older before the start of the summer program (7 October 2024) can play in the Mixed senior competitions.
- Fixtures may start from 6.05pm for Seniors (Monday, Tuesday and Thursdays) and finish by 9.45pm and Juniors (Wednesday) will start at 5pm and finish by 9pm to allow for maximum participation.
- Junior Grass Mixed U10s and Girls 11-18 years competitions to be played at Downey Park on Fields 1 & 9. Games will commence at 8am to reduce playing in the summer heat.

Registration information – new to Hockey for Term 4 – Summer Hockey

• If you have NOT played hockey in 2024 i.e. have not paid the Hockey Australia / Hockey Queensland registration fee, you will need to register and pay via revsport (Junior Term 4 or Senior Term 4) prior to the first fixture via this link -



Teams (dependant on the number of nominations) may be "graded" into divisions/pools to allow similar standard teams to play against each other during the 8-week programs (e.g., Senior PL1-3 & DP1-3 in different pools on the same day/night).

Payments

Upfront payment for Summer Hockey is required and will be invoiced to each team contact when your registration has been completed in revsport. NB the BWHA Office will not debit a credit / debit card each week after you play.

Competition Rules
